

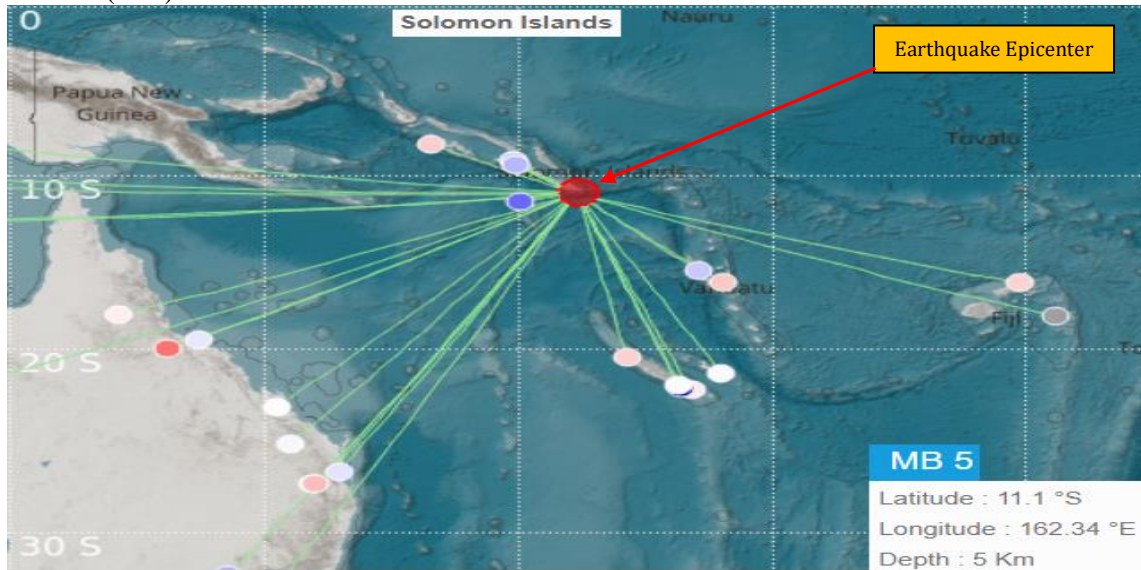

A **moderate** earthquake with a **shallow depth** source location 25 km SSW from Ragapu, Solomon Islands. However this **does not** pose any immediate tsunami threat to the Fiji region.
