

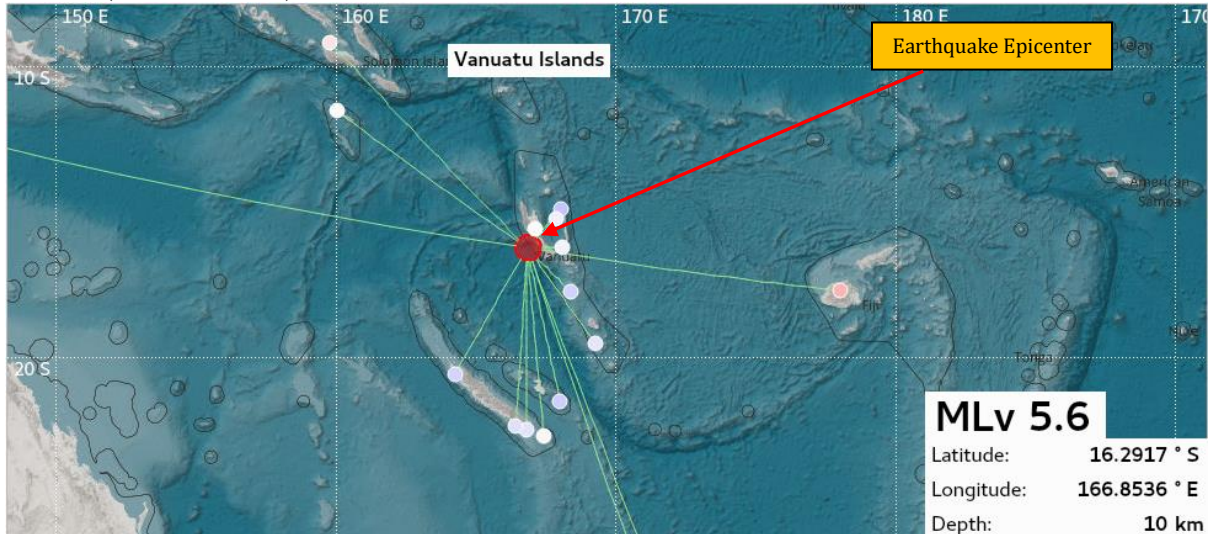

A **moderate** earthquake with a **shallow depth** source location 43 km W from Leviamp, Vanuatu Islands. However this **does not** pose any immediate tsunami threat to the Fiji region.
